

Windows Updates

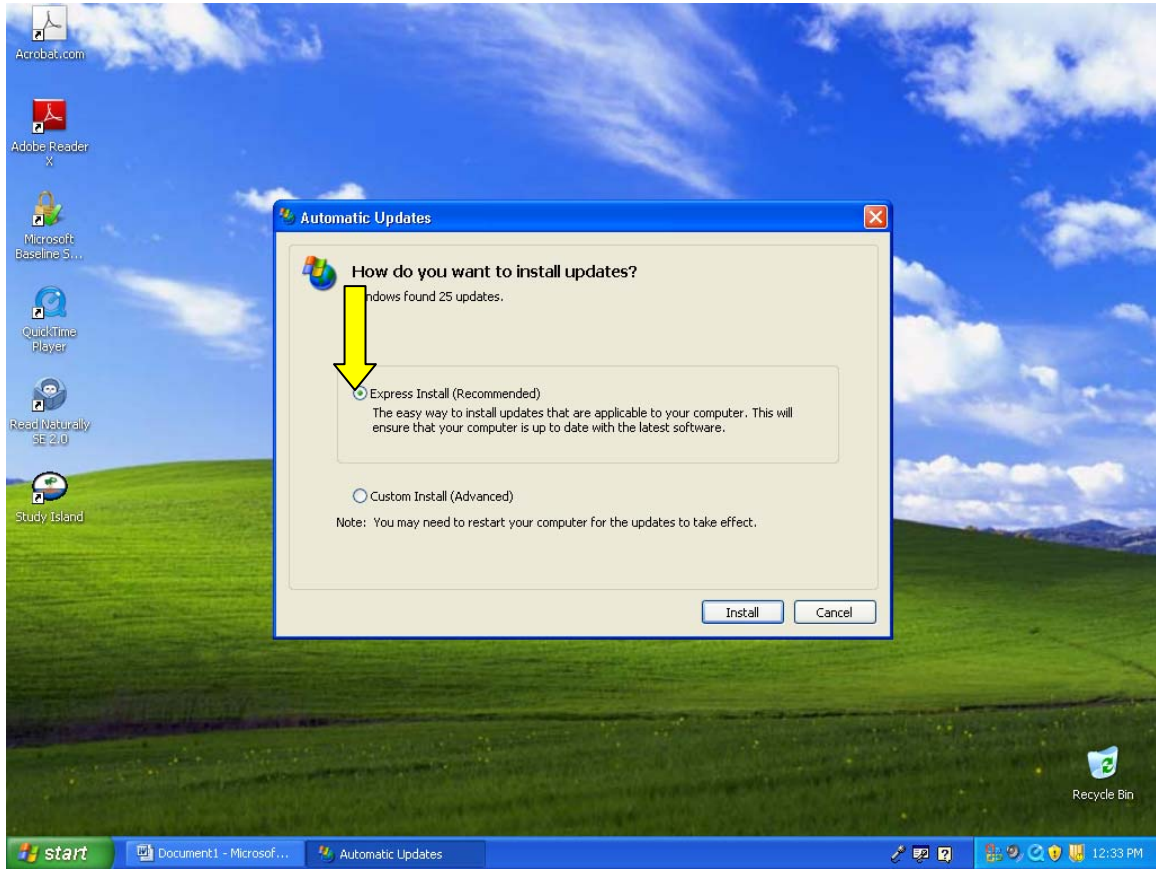
After logging onto your computer, you may notice a small yellow shield at the bottom right-hand side of the task bar. This symbol is letting you know you have windows updates that need to be installed.



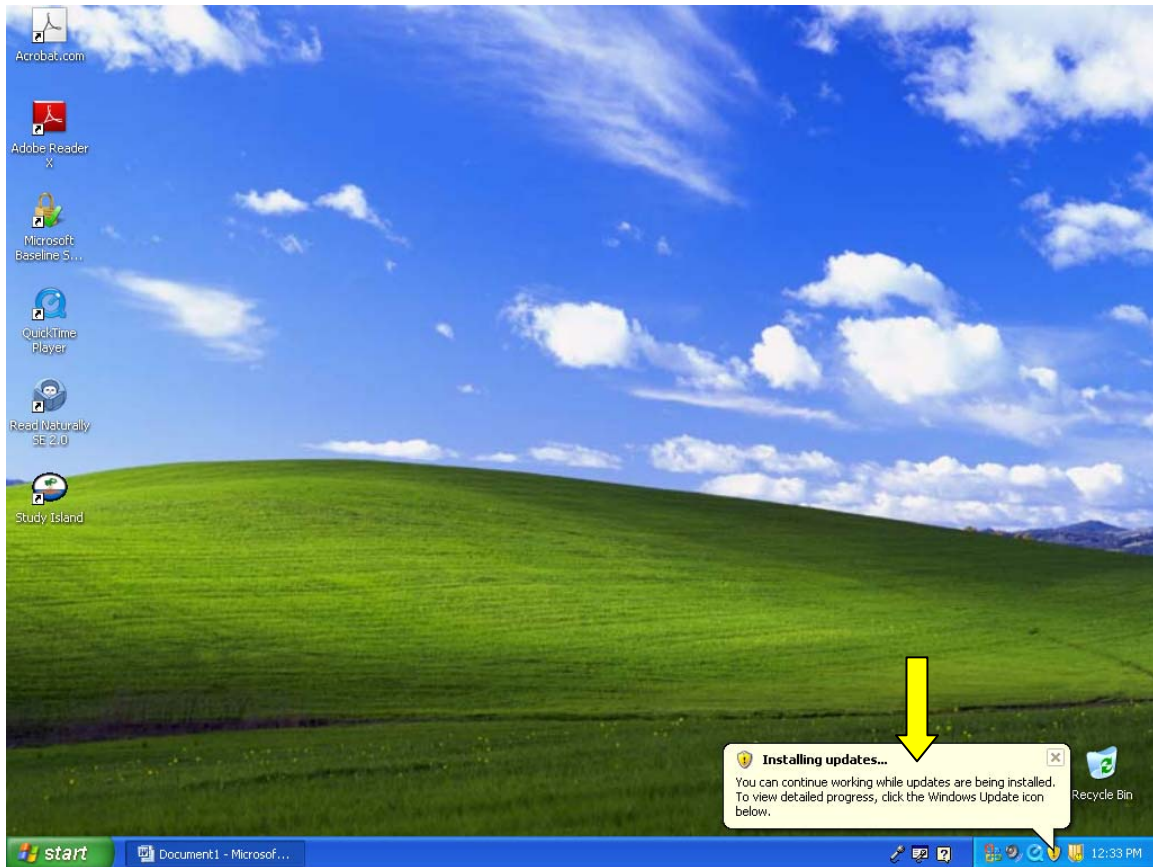
If you hover over the yellow shield, it will tell you that there are updates ready for your computer. Click here to install these updates. Click the yellow shield, so the updates can install.



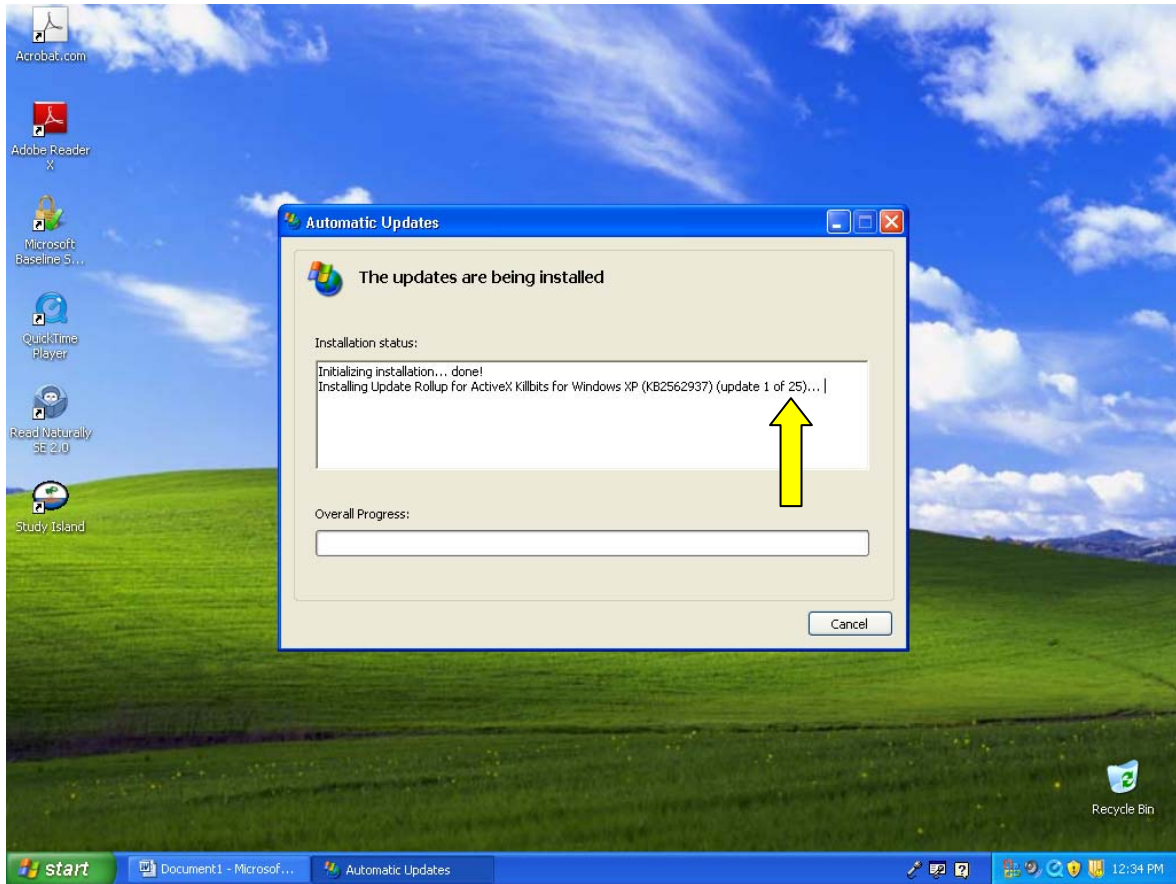
After clicking on the shield, it will tell you how many updates you have, and ask you how you want the updates to install. Always choose Express install (recommended).



Next, the window will go away and a balloon will pop up and say that Updates are being installed, and that you may continue to work while your computer is updating.



You can choose to click on the balloon, and watch the progress as the updates install.



When the update is finished, it may ask you to restart your computer. If you choose to close the window, it will prompt you to restart your computer until you do.
